



The ACT Junior Chess League presents the 2024 WINTER HOLIDAY BOOT CAMP – Long Time Control Tournament –

The ACTJCL 2024 Winter School Holiday Chess Frenzy - Boot Camp long time tournament is a two-day rated event for players born on or after 1 Jan 2004, played with long time controls (60 min + 10s) on Wednesday 10 and Thursday 11 July 2024 at Campbell High. This is a great opportunity to practice before the ANU Open (26-27 July).

Players are expected to record moves but if your child has never recorded moves before or has never played long time control games of chess in a competitive environment, please let us know and we'll provide some instructions prior to the tournament. Please contact us to discuss the format if you are at all unsure.

- When:** Wednesday 10 and Thursday 11 July 2024, 9am until 5pm daily.
Booking is for both days and Registration is from 8.45am
- Where:** Campbell High School Library, Treloar Crescent, Campbell
- Who:** Children born on or after 1 January 2004
- Cost:** \$60 for both days – *great value days of holiday fun!*
- Time Limits:** Time limits will be 60 mins + 10 secs a move
- Awards:** Prizes in the events will include 1st & 2nd overall, and with additional prizes awarded based on the number of entries received. Every player receives a ribbon!
